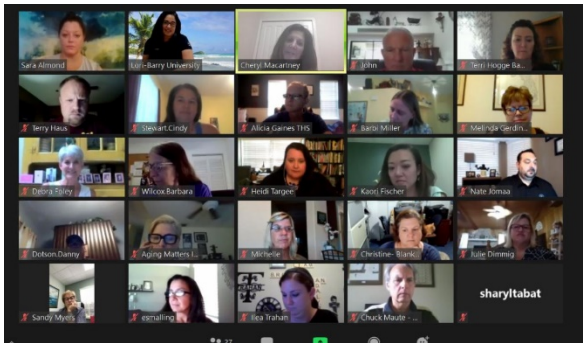

Qualifications

1. Must be at least 21 years of age.
2. Present a valid Social Security and FL Driver's License.
3. Be physically able to perform the duties of a substitute teacher.
4. Have earned the Minimum Education Requirement (HS Diploma or equivalent).
5. Complete all required employment paperwork (See Career Pathway steps)
6. Pass required pre-employment screenings (Drug Screening and Security Clearance).

Additionally, the following qualifications are preferred:

1. Internet access.
2. Adequate and reliable transportation.
3. Availability to work Monday through Friday in all grade levels and subjects.

We know the school year looks different and we are committed to providing the training necessary including additional technical support resources. We are here to provide the tools that help you be part of teaching the future of our community.
